

LINK is a state-of-the-art bus service that invites customers to enjoy rail-like comfort, speed and reliability.

The Main Street LINK in Mesa currently travels from the Superstition Springs Park-and-Ride to the Sycamore Transit Center, connecting to METRO light rail.

The Arizona Ave/ Country Club LINK travels along Arizona Avenue in Chandler and Country Club Dr. in Mesa to connect the Chandler Park and Ride with the Sycamore Transit Center, also connecting with light rail.

Riding the LINK costs as little as \$1.75 for 1-Ride, \$3.50 for a pre-purchased All-day pass that includes all local buses and light rail service, or \$5.25 for an All-day pass purchased on the bus. Reduced passes are available for those who qualify.

Passes can be pre-purchased at participating 7-Eleven, Fry's, Safeway and Walgreens stores.

Fare Vending Machines will be installed at select LINK stations later this year.
