A. Requests for changes to uniform items should be directed to the Uniform Committee in writing. The Uniform Committee will evaluate the requests and present their findings to the executive staff for approval.

B. Uniform Appearance

- 1. Supervisors are responsible for insuring that personnel maintain a professional appearance and utilize only approved uniforms, clothing, accessories and equipment.
- 2. While on-duty or in public view, uniformed personnel shall wear the full uniform of the day. No part of the sworn officer uniform may be worn in conjunction with non-uniform clothing.
- 3. Uniforms and equipment shall be clean and in good repair at all times. Any repairs to the uniform must be inconspicuous.
 - a) Uniforms shall be neatly pressed and not faded.
 - b) All utility belt and metal items shall be neatly shined.
 - c) Pockets, sleeve cuffs and shirtfronts shall be buttoned (except the collar button) and the uniform shirt tucked in at all times.
- 4. Officers are permitted to wear their uniform while off-duty only when traveling to/from work, attending a police funeral, or another detail authorized by the Chief.
- 5. Officers shall not wear their uniform while under suspension.

C. Jewelry

- 1. Employees may wear jewelry that is conservatively styled. Employees are prohibited from wearing any jewelry that is considered inappropriate or offensive to any individual or group.
- 2. Earrings: Uniformed females may wear one stud earring per ear; sworn males may not wear any earrings unless authorized.
- D. **Body Piercing**: Piercing of visible body parts other than those addressed in this order are prohibited.

E. Tattoos

- 1. While on duty, tattoos will only be displayed under the following circumstances:
 - a) Tattoos on the legs will not be visible while in uniform.
 - b) When in civilian attire, visible tattoos on the legs may not extend more than six inches above the center of the ankle bone.
 - c) Tattoos may be displayed on the arms while in uniform or civilian attire.
- 2. The display of any unprofessional or offensive tattoos or brand, regardless of its locations, while employees are on duty or working extra duty in a police capacity is prohibited. The following includes, but is not limited to the types of tattoos that are prohibited:
 - a) Depictions of nudity or violence.
 - b) Sexually explicit or vulgar art, words, phrases, profane language.
 - c) Symbols likely to initiate a strong negative reaction from any group, i.e., swastikas, pentagrams, etc.
 - d) Initials or acronyms that represent criminal or historically oppressive organizations, i.e., AB (Aryan Brotherhood), KKK, SS, street gang name, numbers, and/or symbols.
- 3. Body markings considered inappropriate that are visible must be covered while on duty. Inappropriate or excessive body marking issues will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
- 4. The use of permanent cosmetics shall be conservative in natural colors; no extreme contrasts shall be permitted.

5. Exceptions

- a) When deemed necessary for operations, employees in undercover assignments may display tattoos, brands, or jewelry otherwise prohibited by this order with the approval of the unit lieutenant.
- b) Jewelry or body markings that are an integral part of a recognized religious organization or practice. Questions regarding the practice of an employee's display of a tattoo or jewelry may be submitted for reviewed by the Chief who may seek the approval by an appropriate religious authority.
- c) Non-offensive tattoos, otherwise prohibited by this order because of location may be displayed during department-sanctioned physical fitness activities, etc.
- d) The final authority for deciding the appropriateness of tattoos, any piercing, and jewelry lies with the Chief.

F. Identification and Rank Insignia

- 1. The police identification card shall be carried at all times while in uniform and when carrying a concealed firearm on- or off-duty.
- 2. The breast badge shall be worn over the left pocket of the uniform shirt.
 - a) Upon the death of any department employee the breast badge will be shrouded from the day of notification until internment. Additionally, shrouds are authorized in the event of the death of any Arizona (municipal, county, state, tribal or federal officer stationed in Arizona) law enforcement or corrections officer or any other circumstance as directed by the Chief.
 - b) Shrouds shall be worn from the time of notification of the death until funeral services are complete.
 - c) Shrouds will be plain black (no writing), 3/8" wide elastic and worn horizontally around the center of the badge.
 - d) Badge shrouds for patch badges will be the metal bar pin worn horizontally over the badge, no other form of shroud is approved.
- 3. Round memorial pins may be worn on the Class A or B button down uniform shirts. The pins commemorate GPD officers who have been killed in the line of duty; currently two pins are approved to wear, but are optional. If one pin is worn, it shall be placed on the right corner of the right-pocket flap; if two pins are worn, they shall be placed on opposite corners (one on the right side and one on the left) of the right pocket flap.
- 4. The nameplate is 3/8" and silver with black lettering worn centered on the right shirt pocket attached at the top flush with the top edge of the pocket. The plate will contain the last name, and first one or two initials. Embroidered name patches will be 3/8" with block lettering.
- 5. Active Field Training officers may wear the FTO patch. The patch is worn 1/2", centered, below the shoulder patch. If an officer is both a lead officer and field training officer, only the lead officer chevrons will be worn. The field training patch is not authorized for wear on the Class A uniform shirt.
- 6. The rank insignia shall be worn centered on the edge of each collar, parallel to the top of the collar, except as noted below.

7. Badge Retention

- a) Reassignment: Officers who are reassigned to Investigations will receive a detective badge. If the officer wishes, their original "officer" badge will be held for them in the Quartermaster. Their badge may be retrieved when they are assigned back to Patrol and return their detective badge.
- b) Promotion: Upon promotion, officers may purchase the badge of their lower rank at fair market value (current cost to replace). If an officer chooses to purchase a badge they will be required to sign a badge purchase agreement.

G. Award Ribbons and Pins

- 1. Wearing award ribbons and pins is optional.
- 2. Life Saving and Purple Heart awards received while employed with another agency may be worn once proof of the award is provided to the officer's chain of command.
- 3. Service stripes are worn on all long-sleeved shirts and patrol jackets 1" above the cuff on the left sleeve with the upward slant aligned with the patch point (see Figure 1). One stripe will be issued for each four years of law enforcement service (including Arizona and out-of state certification).
- 4. Advanced Certification/Assignment Pins
 - a) Pins may be worn by officers who are active in the unit/program that the certification was received for. Pins are silver and worn centered 1/2" above the ribbon bar. Once an officer leaves the assignment they may continue to wear the pin provided they left the assignment in good standing.
 - b) A command school pin will be worn on the right side of the right shirt pocket flap.
 - c) No more than one advanced certification/assignment pin may be worn on the Class B uniform; all ribbons and one pin may be worn on Class A uniform.

5. Ribbons

- a) Ribbon bars representing the American flag are centered on the left shirt pocket below the breast badge. Flag pins are authorized for Class A and B uniform shirts and the shirt-style vest carrier.
- b) Award and assignment ribbons will be displayed as shown in the diagram in Appendix B (see Order 108 Awards and Recognition for ribbon specifications).
- H. **Dress Standards Uniformed Personnel**: Sworn officers will maintain a properly fitting Class A and Class B Uniform. Any alterations must be made at the seams.

- I. Jackets: Patrol uniform jackets shall be dark blue with long sleeves.
 - 1. Shoulder patch placement is the same as the uniform shirt.
 - 2. Jackets may have either cloth badge and name tag or metal badge and name plate; metal and cloth will not be mixed. Insignia items for rank of lieutenant and above shall be metal.
 - 3. Department-issued motor jacket will not have a name tag.
- J. Raincoats: Yellow waist length, with optional hood, with black block letters "POLICE" on the back: Officers who purchased the knee length rain jackets prior to January 1, 2013, will not be required to replace them.

K. Hats:

- 1. Unit-specific hats may only be worn when working in that unit (for example, officers working routine patrol will not wear traffic unit or SWAT hats).
- 2. Investigations personnel may wear hats based on seasonal/environmental conditions at the discretion of the Investigations commander.

L. Footwear:

- 1. Black oxford-type shoe or boot or Oakley brand boots with smooth finish.
- 2. Plain white crew-length socks for the summer shorts uniform.
- 3. Plain black socks will be worn with uniform pants if the socks can be seen.
- M. **Authorized Equipment for Extended Outdoor Duties:** Officers assigned to outdoor duties that require exposure to sunlight for an anticipated period exceeding 30 minutes, the following items may be worn/used. These items <u>may not</u> be used during regular patrol duties.

- 1. Camel back hydration system.
- 2. Black "Boonie" hat (see Section K).

N. Duty Belt and Accessories

- 1. Approved duty belt and accessories as listed in Appendix B.
- 2. Duty belt items will be visibly consistent in appearance and will not be mixed. Basket-weave items are prohibited. Leather or leather look items are approved but will not be issued; they may be purchased at the officer's expense and may not be mixed with the department issued gear.
- 3. Accessories will be placed on the duty belt in a neat, orderly and convenient location.
- 4. Batons: Are an optional piece of equipment.
 - a) Expandable batons must be a minimum of 21" when fully expanded and have friction or auto lock design.
 - b) Plainclothes officers may carry a baton as situations necessitate.
- 5. Other accessories include, but are not limited to:
 - a) Flashlight holder
 - b) Key strap and ring
 - c) Radio holder
 - d) Handcuffs and case; double handcuff cases are approved
- 6. Holster: Will have a thumb break snap release and a secondary retention such as molded, form fitted or adjustable friction. Holsters shall be hi-ride or mid-ride style.
- 7. Pepper spray and carrier.
- 8. Optional folding knife with locking blade (blade not to exceed four inches) may be purchased at the officer's expense; knives will not be issued.
- O. **Outer Vest Carrier Options**: There are two types of outer vest carriers that approved for wear. No modifications may be made to either style of outer vest carrier without the approval of the Chief.
 - 1. Molle-style carrier: Black Point Blank "Gilbert Light and Long" outer carrier
 - a) May be worn with short or long sleeved Class B and Class C daily uniform and with approved special duty uniforms.
 - b) Approved molle attachments (molle attachments shall not be "double stacked," they must be attached to the vest):
 - (1) Admin pouch with OC attachment.
 - (2) Recorder pouch (may be attached to the admin pouch)
 - (3) Taser soft or hard holster
 - (4) Spare Taser cartridge holders
 - (5) Single rifle magazine pouch (double magazine pouch approved for CAT officers)
 - (6) Flashlight holder
 - (7) Trauma kit holder
 - (8) Camera/cell phone holder
 - c) Embroidered cloth badge on the left chest; embroidered name tag patch with silver thread letters on the right chest.
 - d) Optional motor wings or SWAT insignia on the right chest.
 - e) Silver embroidered rank insignia, lieutenant or higher on the shoulder on the epaulet.
 - f) "POLICE" in 1" reflective lettering on the front and embroidered 2" letters on 4" x 11" Velcro patch on the centered on the back.
 - g) No other patches are authorized for wear on the molle carrier.
 - 2. Shirt style carrier: Blauer Armorskin #8370, dark navy
 - a) To be worn with the Class B button up shirt, long or short sleeved, only.

- b) The breast badge shall be worn over the left pocket of the outer vest carrier.
- c) A metal nameplate (as described in Section F.4) is worn centered on the right shirt pocket attached at the top flush with the top edge of the pocket.
- P. Officers will be required to wear a metal breast badge and name plate on their uniform shirt under the carrier; therefore they will be issued a second badge and name plate. Each officer and/or police vehicle shall be issued a protective bio-hazard disposable clothing kit.
- Q. **Issuing Uniform Duty Gear and Equipment:** Officers in need of new or replacement uniform items/gear due to normal wear shall:
 - 1. Demonstrate the need for the replacement to their supervisor.
 - 2. Complete a Quartermaster Requisition form including the items needed and their supervisor's signature indicating approval.
 - 3. Return the requisition to the quartermaster.
 - 4. The quartermaster will complete the order and notify the employee when their items may be picked up.
 - 5. Items being replaced due to normal wear and tear or because of size changes will be turned into the quartermaster.
 - 6. All items will be replaced with department issued items

R. Replacement of Items Damaged During Performance of Duty

- 1. Complete a Quartermaster Requisition form including a copy of the DR and a description of the damaged items. The form shall be signed by the supervisor indicating their approval.
- 2. Return the completed form to the quartermaster.
- 3. Items being replaced will be turned into the quartermaster.
- 4. The quartermaster will complete the order and notify the employee when their items may be picked up.
- 5. All items will be replaced with approved and issued by the department.

S. **Authorized Civilian Clothing** (Sworn and Non-Sworn Personnel)

- 1. General Regulations: Conservative business attire, accessories, and shoes. T-shirts, shorts, athletic apparel, blue jeans, athletic style shoes, and flip flop casual style shoes are prohibited. Blue denim jeans and cargo pants without rips, tears, or holes may be worn on Fridays with a collared shirt (button-up or polo).
 - a) Section managers may deviate from this Order when appropriate for business operations (e.g., SIT, dispatchers, 911 operators).
 - b) Sworn officers on light duty will conform to non-sworn (civilian) dress requirements based on their assignment (see Section S.2 below).
 - c) Holsters: Black or brown holsters made with an integral locking device and a secondary retention such as molded, form fitted or adjustable friction. Fanny packs, belt pack, or handbag purses used to carry or conceal a firearm must have an integrated holster or a separate secure compartment specifically designed to hold the firearm. Any concealed holster must have either a thumb break, secondary retention such as molded, form fitted, or adjustable friction, or have sufficient retention capabilities to reasonably defend against take-away by an adversary. Written permission must be obtained from the officer's supervisor to carry a fanny pack or belt pack. A copy will be forwarded to the firearms instructor.
 - d) Badges will be displayed when the weapon is exposed.

2. Rank/Position Dress Regulations

a) Male - All Sworn and Civilian Managers: Dress shirts (button up, collared) and ties between November 1 and March 31 and year-round for court or meetings involving members of the public. Between April 1 and October 31, ties shall not be required and collared polo-style shirts may be worn.

- b) Male Civilian Non-Managers: Dress should be appropriate to a business environment; Casual dress pants and collared shirts free of advertisement (shirts with the brand's logo embroidered on it are permitted e.g., Ralph Lauren polo pony).
- c) Female Sworn Officers and Civilian Managers: Skirts of a reasonable length (no mini-skirts), pants, (long, cropped or dressy Capri-length) and top. Skirts with high slits, halter or strapless tops are not appropriate. Shoes with closed toe.
- d) Female Civilian Non-Managers: Skirts of a reasonable length (no mini-skirts), pants (either long, cropped or dressy Capri-length) and top. Skirts with high slits, halter, or strapless tops are not appropriate.
- T. **Training**: When attending classroom/lecture training (whether in-house or through an outside source), employees are required to comply with Section S of this Order. Training that involves defensive tactics or similar practical training shall be permitted to wear clothing conducive to such training (i.e., cargo pants, jeans, etc.), the training orders shall indicate the appropriate attire.

U. Grooming Standards

1. Hair must be neat, combed, clean, and conservatively styled. Hair color should be natural with no extreme contrasts.

2. Males

- a) Shall not cover the ears or extend below the top of the uniform collar at the back of the neck when the head is in a normal position.
- b) Hair cannot cover the eyebrows when groomed.
- c) No foreign items will be attached to, or otherwise be part of the hair style.
- d) Sideburns:
 - (1) Must be neatly trimmed and tapered in the same manner as the haircut.
 - (2) Must be straight and of even width.
 - (3) Must end in a clean-shaven, horizontal line that must not extend below the bottom of the earlobe.
 - (4) May not be flared or bushy in style.
- e) Facial hair
 - (1) Sworn and uniformed civilians (Civilian Patrol Assistants, Crime Prevention, Jail Transport, Teleserve, and volunteers): Facial hair cannot extend below the top lip, on the chin or below the sideburns on the jaw; must not interfere with respiratory mask seal (see Order 407, Respiratory Protection).
 - (2) Civilian: Facial hair must be kept neatly trimmed.

3. Females

- a) Hair shall be worn in a conservative style. Accessories (barrettes, combs, ponytail holders) shall be black, navy, or the same color as the hair and may not interfere with the helmet. If more than one is worn, they must be the same color.
- b) Uniformed employees (sworn and civilian as noted above): Hair will not extend past the bottom of the uniform shirt collar; if worn in a braid or ponytail it will not extend more than 6" past the bottom of the collar.
