Dear PKID Property Owner,

The common areas and rights of way within your subdivision are maintained through a special assessment district known as a **Parkway Maintenance Improvement District (PKID). Your neighborhood is: PKID 07-03 – Park Village.** Special assessment district costs are added to your property tax bill each year on a per lot basis.

Your PKID annual meeting was held in November 2018, to answer questions, clarify information, identify and discuss required maintenance items and receive potential ballot suggestions. At the meeting, staff discussed the current assessment costs and presented information and cost estimates for the following **Potential 1-Year Projects**:

• Potential Project 1

Repair Common Area Walls with Water Damage - Estimate = \$12,254.40 Lighting Enhancements at Quartz and Encinas - Estimate = \$18,917.50 Total for Both Projects Combined = \$31,171.90

WALLS - this portion of the project cost is based on an estimate that 20% of the walls need water damage repair. If the project is approved, an assessment will be done to identify needed repairs. Prior PKID renovations moved the irrigation off the walls, eliminating further sprinkler damage.

LIGHTS - this part of the project is to install a total of three lights. The existing light at the playground would be replaced as part of the project. The new lights would be pathway type lights with a concrete base as opposed to a court or field light.

• Potential Project 2 – Refresh the Decomposed Granite in the Common Areas Estimate = \$85,240.88

This project would top off all of the granite areas with a one inch-thick layer of half-inch screened granite in the current color. The project would take approximately two weeks to complete.

The residents in attendance had no additional items they wished to see placed on a ballot to be voted on by the homeowners for the upcoming FY2019-2020. However, next year there may be ballot items for your consideration based on ideas received at the next Annual Meeting.

The following is a breakdown of your monthly Base Assessments and any potential project costs. Potential project costs will only be added to the Base Assessment if approved by a majority vote of the PKID 07-03 Park Village property owners. Assessment costs begin after July 1, 2019.
