CACTUS YARDS RULES

Park Rules Prohibit

- Outside food and drink (water is allowed)*
- Alcohol leaving the fenced area
- Smoking except in designated areas
- Littering
- Glass containers
- Interference with reserved use areas
- Abusing facilities/disruptive behavior
- Unreasonable noise
- Motorized vehicles (unless permitted)
- Solicitation or posting of handbills
- Dangerous acts such as the use of weapons or projectiles
- Overnight Recreation Vehicle parking
- Parking in areas not designated as parking spots
- Use of an area of the park that has been designated as closed

Coolers with ice and water are allowed in the park, but must be kept in the stands and/or dugouts. Coolers are subject to search upon entry

Pet Requirements

- Dogs must be kept on a leash or in a dog carrier*
- Dogs are not allowed in Sliders Sports
 Grill, the Fieldhouse, in the dugouts or on
 the fields, with the exception of service
 animals
- Dogs must be picked up after

Be advised: the walking surface of the park is made entirely of concrete. Please be mindful of your pet's feet while walking. There are lawns available at the front entrance of the park.

Permits Required For

- Organized field practice, directed fitness, or commercial activity
- Special equipment, including but not limited to inflatable
- Sale of goods (food, beverages, etc.) or services
- Rocket Launching
- Special Events

Ballfield Rules

- Climbing on or over fences is prohibited
- "Soft Toss" against the fence is prohibited
- Hitting against the fence is not allowed
- Unpermitted vehicles are not allowed on fields
- Un-sportsmanlike conduct, fighting, and foul language will not be tolerated
- Use established base distances only; no throw down bases
- Alcohol is prohibited in the dugouts and on the fields
- No smoking in the dugouts or on the fields
- No sitting on top of the dugouts
- No climbing on the outfield structures
- Failure to follow the rules will result in removal from the park and loss of privileges
