

FACILITY USE RULES AND GUIDELINES

McQueen Park Activity Center



1. Children ages 12 and older may utilize the McQueen Park Activity Center unattended. Children under the age of 12 not participating in a registration based program, event or class must be accompanied and supervised by an adult age 18 years or older at all times.
2. All persons in the facility are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that is courteous and respectful of other guests, staff, the facility and equipment. Compromising your safety or the safety of others, verbal or physical threats, aggressive behavior or fighting will result in immediate suspension of all parties.
3. This facility is a family-friendly environment. Clothing with offensive content is prohibited. Appropriate attire is required at all times to include shirts covering the entire torso, pants/shorts and shoes.
4. Photographs without an individual's permission are prohibited. This includes use of all technology with built-in camera devices. (i.e. cell phones, PDA's, cameras, etc.)
5. Music and other personal media equipment should be utilized with headphones or earbuds. The use of external speaker systems is prohibited.
6. Bikes, skateboards, rollerblades/skates, scooters and other recreational motorized/wheeled devices are prohibited inside the building and should be secured in designated racks outside the facility. Locks are available for checkout with a valid ID.
7. The center assumes no responsibility for personal items. All patrons are encouraged to secure their own possessions.
8. Only service animals as defined by state statute are permitted in the facility. Unless part of a Town sponsored or approved activity, no other animals are allowed.
9. Smoking of any kind is prohibited at facility entrances and inside the building. Designated smoking areas are provided 25 feet from the main entrance.
10. Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs may not be consumed prior to or while using the facility. Staff reserves the right to refuse service to anyone suspected of being under the influence.
11. Food, chewing gum and drinks are permitted in lobby areas only. Glass containers are prohibited at all times. Water is allowed throughout the facility if in a sealed, shatterproof container.
12. Only registered participants, permit holders, day pass users and facility staff are allowed in classrooms and/or the gymnasium.
13. Facility guests are required to purchase a wristband and sign a waiver of liability prior to participating in gymnasium activities. Wristbands are your proof of purchase and must be worn at all times.
14. Team coaching, personal training, direct or indirect supervision of organized practices and/or drills are prohibited without a facility permit and certificate of insurance.
15. Recreation equipment is available for check out at the Guest Services Center with a photo ID.

GYMNASIUM USE RULES AND GUIDELINES

McQueen Park Activity Center



1. Gymnasium guests are required to purchase a wristband and sign a waiver of liability prior to participating in gymnasium activities. Wristbands are your proof of purchase and must be worn at all times.
2. Team coaching, personal training, direct or indirect supervision of organized practices and/or drills are prohibited without a facility permit and certificate of insurance.
3. Water must be in a sealed, shatterproof container. Food, chewing gum, other beverages and coolers are prohibited.
4. Appropriate exercise attire to include t-shirts covering the entire torso, soft-soled non-marking athletic shoes, and athletic pants/shorts are required at all times. Sandals, bare feet, steel-toed boots, black-soled and other marking shoes are prohibited.
5. Music and other personal media equipment should be utilized with headphones or earbuds. The use of external speaker systems is prohibited.
6. All games are self-monitored. Good sportsmanship and proper conduct is expected at all times. Gambling, profane words and gestures, littering, and spitting are prohibited.
7. Courts may be broken down into half-court games to accommodate guests and/or programming needs. Staff reserves the right to modify games and/or court usage.
8. Grabbing or hanging on the nets or rims is prohibited.
9. Theft, compromising safety, verbal or physical threats, aggressive behavior or fighting will result in immediate removal from the facility and the suspension of all parties.
10. The center assumes no responsibility for personal items. All patrons are encouraged to secure their own possessions.
11. Use of personal tables and chairs is prohibited in the gymnasium. Please see a staff member if you require special seating accommodations.
