

NOTICE OF INTENT- PROPOSED NEW OR INCREASED FEES Ambulance Transportation Billing Rates Fire and Rescue Department

In accordance with A.R.S. §9-499.15, notice is hereby given that the Gilbert Town Council will consider the following Ambulance Transportation Rates at the Regular Town Council Meeting on Tuesday, June 14, 2022, at 6:30 pm at the Gilbert Public Safety Training Facility – Atlas Auditorium, 6860 S. Power Road, Gilbert, AZ 85295.

The Arizona Department of Health Services (DHS) regulates the provision of ambulance transportation services, including billing rates, in the state. DHS performs an annual review of market and provider financial conditions to determine if changes in billing rates are warranted. The most recent evaluation by DHS identified the need for a rate increase for providers in the Phoenix region. Based on the current DHS regulations Gilbert has the option of requesting several different rate increases. The Gilbert Town Council will consider the options presented below.
