Permit Descriptions for Engineering Construction types:

– Concrete

 This permit is for Off-site concrete site work on both commercial and residential construction projects that is not associated with a commercial or residential construction permit.

• - Drainage Drywells

 This permit is for constructing a new drywell for an existing drainage system or structure that is not associated with a commercial or residential construction permit.

• - Dry Utilities

 This permit is for the construction of dry utilities for a utility company licensed to provide service in the Town of Gilbert.

– Effluent

This permit is for the construction of a reclaimed water system or connection to an
existing reclaimed water system that is not associated with a commercial or residential
construction permit.

• - Grading - Subdivisions/Commercial

• This permit is for grading construction activities associated with the development of a subdivision or commercial project.

Landscape

 This permit is for landscape construction activities that are not associated with a commercial or residential construction permit.

– Miscellaneous – Engineering

 This permit is for miscellaneous construction activities that are not associated with a commercial or residential construction permit. Permits for potholing activities will be issued under this permit type.

– Paving

 This permit is for Off-Site paving work on both commercial and residential construction projects that is not associated with a commercial or residential construction permit.

– Sewer

 This permit is for the construction of a sanitary sewer connection/extension to an existing sanitary sewer system that is not associated with a commercial or residential construction permit.

Streetlight

 This permit is for the construction of a streetlight that is not associated with a commercial or residential construction permit.

– Water

 This permit is for the construction of a water connection/extension to an existing water distribution system that is not associated with a commercial or residential construction permit.
